

# **The Ohio Chapter IAWP Hall of Fame**

**Established in 1980 in memory of Conner H. Sayers Sr., the Ohio Chapter IAWP Hall of Fame honors those of our fellow members whose achievements in IAWP are outstanding. Induction is the highest honor a member of the Ohio Chapter IAWP can achieve.**

**Nominations should be submitted to the current president of the Past Presidents Club.**

**Only those nominations received by the deadline of July 31<sup>st</sup> of the current year will be considered. The nomination(s) and any attachments will become the property of the Ohio Chapter IAWP and will not be returned.**

# Eligibility and Selection Criteria

- ❑ Nominee must be a current member of the Ohio Chapter IAWP. In case of posthumous induction, the nominee would have had to be a member at death (unless retired). In case of a retiree, the nominee would have had to be a member at time of retirement.
- ❑ Nominee must have at least 15 years minimum membership in IAWP
- ❑ Any current IAWP member may submit a nomination(s).
- ❑ Nominations must be typed double-spaced. Not more than two (2) pages will be reviewed for each nomination.
- ❑ Nominations will be based only on IAWP accomplishments. Provide in summary form the nominee's achievements to include:
  - Description of all significant accomplishments to include dates and positions held and whether it was at local, state, national or international levels.
  - An explanation of the uniqueness of the nominees' contributions beyond the normal realm of duties to the Ohio Chapter IAWP and its members - to include participation and promotion of IAWP, endeavors to improve IAWP/Ohio Chapter and the inspiration given to fellow members in the performance of IAWP responsibilities.
  - An account of how the achievements is or was unprecedented, unequalled or a first for the Ohio Chapter IAWP and a significant benefit to its members.
  - A chronological listing of significant awards received by the nominee that demonstrated and maintained the professional standard of IAWP.

*Nominations will be reviewed by the voting members of the Ohio Chapter IAWP Executive Board following the criteria above with the results forwarded to the Hall of Fame Chair for confirmation. Selection of the nominee will require at least 2/3-approval vote by the Board. Induction to the Hall of Fame will be made at the Fall Conference. Nominations not chosen for induction will not be returned nor held for consideration in succeeding years.*
