Ohio Chapter IAWP Conference

IAWP Fall 2007 Conference Registration



The Youngstown Sub-chapter of IAWP cordially invites you to the annual IAWP Fall Education Conference on October 4th and 5th, 2007 at **The Avalon Inn Resort & Conference Center**, 9519 East Market Street, Warren, OH. Call hotel directly to make reservations at 330-856-1900 or 330-743-4000 or 800-828-2566. Be sure to mention IAWP. You must reserve room no later than September 21, 2007.

DIRECTIONS: See Map Quest for more directions.

From Youngstown – take Route 193 North exit (Belmont Avenue) to Warren-Sharon Road (in Vienna). Turn left. Avalon Inn is approximately 5 miles down on the right.

From Boardman/Canfield – take 11 North to 82 west. When merging onto 82 west, get into the far right lane. At the first stoplight (about ¼ mile down) on 82 west, turn right onto Howland-Wilson Road until it dead ends Market Street (Warren-Sharon Road). Turn right onto East Market Street. Avalon Inn is ¼ mile down on the left.

From Akron/Canton/Columbus – Take 77 north to 76 east. Follow 76 East to 80 East. (Note: 76 and 80 join; stay on 80 East, DO NOT follow PA Turnpike) Follow 80 East until 11 north. Follow 11 North to 82 West (left-hand exit). At the first stoplight (about ¼ mile down) on 82 West, turn right onto Howland-Wilson Road until it dead ends Market Street (Warren-Sharon Road). Turn right onto East Market Street. Avalon Inn is ¼ mile down on the left.

From Cleveland – Take 271 South to 422 East to Route 5/82 East to Sharon. Route 5 will exit off the highway, however, stay on 82, come to the Howland-Wilson intersection. Turn left onto Howland-Wilson Road until it dead ends into East Market Street (Warren-Sharon Road). Turn right onto East Market Street. Avalon Inn is ¼ mile down on the left.

ROOM RATES: \$79.00 plus tax. Activities include indoor pool, workout and training center, indoor/outdoor tennis courts and golf course. Breakfast is included for those staying at the Hotel.

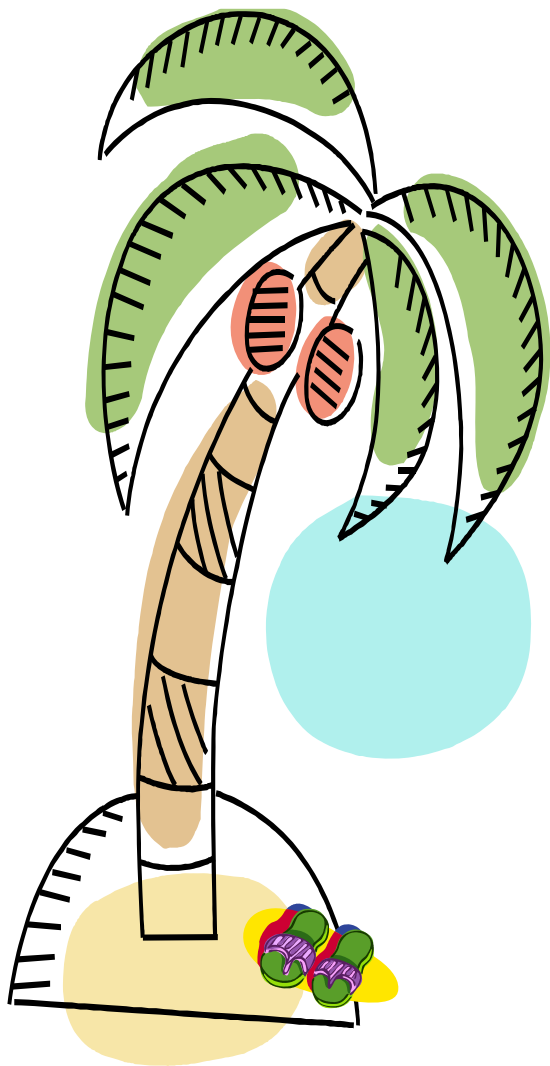
